Meeting

Meet from 2.15 pm for a prompt start at 2.30 pm at the clock tower by the tourist information centre, in the town centre. Postcode BS37 6AH

The High Street has free parking (with no time limit on Sundays) along its length, and there is also a free public car park close to the church.

There are public toilets nearby but if these are closed, there are also pubs and supermarkets where toilets are available.

Walk Details

The walk will be led by John Chandler

Chipping Sodbury has the most attractive and interesting High Street, and, in its layout and development, exhibits the characteristics of a medieval planted town, still remarkably preserved.

We shall meet at the clock tower in the town centre and make short walking forays in several directions in order to appreciate its topography and buildings.

Most of the walk will be on level ground, with a few steps and slopes, but we shall not stray any great distance from the High Street.

We aim to finish by about 4.30.

There are opportunities for refreshments in establishments in the town centre.
