1. Accounting Policies

The accounts have been prepared on the accruals basis, showing income receivable and expenditure incurred with regard to the current financial year.

3. GLHA Local History Day

The 2024 GLHA Local History Day was held at Hartpury University on Saturday 27 July 2024. The income of £1,080 from this event came entirely from admission charges: 90 people at £12 per person. The total cost of the event was £1,497, leaving a shortfall of £417 to be funded by the Association.
