Members' Forum: Monday 8th December 2025
Treasurer's Report

This report should be read in conjunction with the Statement of Accounts I have produced for the first seven months of this financial year, April to October 2025.

There has been very little change in the state of the Association's finances since my last report to GLHA members, at the Forum in September, which stated the position at the end of August this year. Since then, income has increased by £173 to a year-to-date figure of £1,000, while expenditure has increased by £145 to a year-to-date figure of £521. Consequently, at the end of October the net income received by the Association so far this year was £479, increasing overall funds to £3,453.

The main contributor to the increase in both income and expenditure between the end of August and the end of October was the Bryan Jerrard Award, amounting to £100 in each case. We are most grateful to The History Press for sponsoring this event, which enabled us to present prizes of £60 and £40, respectively, to the winner and runner-up of this year's award.

Also of note is that, since August, the number of paid-up members of the Association has increased to 53, with one more of last year's members renewing their membership. That leaves just 3 of last year's members who have not yet renewed this year.

Since the end of October this year, up until the date of this report, we have received no further income nor incurred any further expenditure and the accounts for this year remain as shown at 31st October.
